The position offers a comprehensive environment for conducting research, including travel funds, and a state-of-the-art experimental laboratory. The position can be filled as soon as possible. The salary is based on the German E13 TV-L.

The professorship of Behavioral Service Management at the Department of Business Administration and Healthcare Management of the University of Cologne invites applications for a position as a doctoral researcher. The successful candidate will conduct independent research at the intersection between behavioral economics and healthcare management under the supervision of Prof. Dr. Daniel Wiesen, who is a member of Faculty of Management, Economics, and Social Sciences.

Candidates should be committed to do research related to issues in healthcare management using methods from behavioral and experimental economics. They should have a Master's degree in Economics, Management, Health Economics, or a related field, and sound knowledge in microeconomic theory and/or econometrics. Proficiency in English is a prerequisite. German language skills are desirable but not required; good command of statistic software packages such as STATA and other programming skills are a plus.
